

NOTES

Dogs must be at least 3 months old to begin Obedience training and 12 months old to begin Agility training (dogs may only begin full height obstacles and competing in agility from 18 months of age).

All dogs must be fully vaccinated before attending classes, if your dog is unwell, leave him/her at home.

If you or your Instructor consider your dog to be a threat to another dog or person, the club has blue ribbons available to tie on the collar or lead, this will ensure you and your dog are given a 'safety zone'. (Remember, if your dog causes damage to another dog or person, it is your fault, and you are liable for any loss or damage incurred)

Bitches in season are not allowed to attend classes, please keep yours at home.

All dogs should be on a lead at all times, unless otherwise directed by your Instructor.

The Club neither accepts nor condones harsh handling.

Please, no smoking, eating or drinking during training. You are most welcome to stay after training for a free cup of tea or coffee and a chat. No dogs or smoking inside the clubrooms.

Do not feed your dog before coming to training, the dog will be uncomfortable working on a full stomach. You may also wish to give your dog a run before training, to let off excess steam.

Try to get your dog to go to the toilet before training. However, if your dog does have an accident, the club as a pooper scooper, bucket and mop for you to clean it up. Don't be too embarrassed – it's happened to us all!

It is advisable to wear comfortable flat shoes suitable for outdoors (the grounds can be slippery during winter), and a coat as it can be quite windy.

We recommend a soft slip lead or collar for training and don't forget your dog's favourite toy or food.
